HAMFEST:

Hamfest is OVER! Well done everyone!

As most of you know, after many years of attending, we lost a major new equipment vendor, Hamworld, and were unable to replace it with another. Unfortunately, size does matter and several other smaller equipment vendors have simply disappeared from the hamfest circuits. This year we had to adjust and consolidated commercial and inside vendor tables into the First Christian Church Memorial Hall and almost filled it up.

Setup began early Friday morning with our loyal commercial vendors arriving to unload - Tower Electronics, Signman of Baton Rouge, Satellite Sam, J.T. Communications and Paradan Radio. We had some interesting individual vendors also setting up: Hayden's Computers, Frank Intino, Estate of Terry Reaves W4FG, Sal & Donna Vilione and Kevin Young.

Member participation was outstanding. We had 26 members who volunteered over Friday and Saturday to make Hamfest 2023 successful. Lots of help made the work go quickly and efficiently. In terms of attendance, we had 239 inside admissions including vendors and member volunteers. The tailgate area had 29 paid spots and attracted a lot of traffic. Our grand prize, a Yaseu FTM-300DR, must have been really well received because we sold 146 tickets. To cap it off, the 50 / 50 drawing drew a lot of interest as well.

As a first for the SSRC, Andy Allen secured a W1AW/4 VOTA special event station operating time slot on 20m phone on Saturday from 8:00am – 2:00pm. A 20m dipole had been previously setup outside on Friday with station equipment provided by Andy. The various operators made about 200 Qs during the six hour block, but acoustics made it challenging.

For another SSRC first, Doug Niessen, K6STS, built and had on display a long duration floater Pico balloon to be launched at Hamfest using the K4GSO call. Unfortunately, the low cloud cover that kept the tailgate folks cool is not conducive for balloon launches. The balloon will be launched at another time.

HAMFEST 2024:

Mark your calendars for next year's Hamfest: December 6 for vendor setup; December 7 for event day. Same venue – First Christian Church – has been reserved. After many years as Hamfest Chairman, 2023 was my last year. It is time to move over and let other interested members have a turn. It is not hard and my existing planning product is available. With 125 members, we have a lot of talent to draw on. A healthy organization plans for succession and that time is now.


GREEN CLOVER HALL:

Please plan to take any leftovers home with you. Our party venue has no refrigeration or food service facilities. If your dish requires a special serving utensil, please provide it.




