

HAMFEST:

It probably isn't on your mind right now, but Hamfest is now only two months away. Setup will be Friday, December 1 and the event will take place on Saturday the 2nd at First Christian Church. The ARRL has officially sanctioned our event, the venue reservation has been "reconfirmed" and planning continues to make this another successful event. All of our vendors have been contacted to confirm their commitment and we've had good response to date. There are several vendors who have not responded but they have until 10/31 to do so. We are also looking for another new equipment vendor.

POTA AT SILVER SPRINGS STATE PARK K-1915:

Last month's Operating Day on 9/30 at Silver Springs State Park was a blast. We had 25 members and guests show up to participate over the four hours we were there. Six stations were set up at various times during the morning. Activities began at 8:00am when the park opened with several members staking down operating positions in two of the three covered pavilions. A lot of time was spent by the more experienced activators explaining how they set up their stations. Each operator's setup was different so there was a lot learn. At the end of the event, five members and guests achieved their first valid activation with ten or more QSOs.

For those who are interested in POTA activities, there are five "Official Events". Events start at 0000 UTC and end 2359 UTC on the days listed. They are:

- New Year's Week (first full week of the new year)
- Support Your Parks on the third full weekend of each quarter. These are "activity weekends" where the objective is to get out in the parks and have as much fun as possible.
 - Winter 3rd Full Weekend in January
 - Spring 3rd Full Weekend in April
 - Summer 3rd Full Weekend in July
 - Autumn 3rd Full Weekend in October.

October 21-22 is the Autumn event, so get out there and spend a little time as an activator or as a hunter from your QTH. It's a lot of fun and a great way to see what works, or doesn't, for your portable setup. For more info on PO-TA, please go to https://pota.app/

What is it and what's the point?

It's a public 24/7 listening SDR (software defined radio) installed at Green Clover Hall currently connected to the Off-Center fed Dipole. Use it to listen to the HF bands from anywhere. Check band conditions. Listen for your own signal. Compare reception between your station and GCH.


How does it work?

It uses open source OpenWebRX+ software running on a Raspberry Pi in the GCH shack.

How do I use it?

Visit http://k4gso.com/sdr. The controls are at the lower right. You can change bands, frequencies, and modes (USB/LSB/Digital/etc).


Free General Class Course on Zoom


